

Policy Title: Unprofessional* Clinical Performance

Policy

Unprofessional* nursing practice in the clinical setting is grounds for failure of the course or other appropriate action. (See policy U4400 Professional Behavior for rules regarding professional clinical conduct.)

Procedure

- A. The instructor will inform the student in writing that he/she has performed unacceptably in the clinical setting and is in danger of failing the course.
- B. A second unacceptable nursing practice incident will result in the instructor informing the student in writing that he/she has failed the course, why he/she failed and that the student will receive a grade of "F". The student will not be able to withdraw without penalty as a result of this action.
- C. Violation of safe clinical practice may be grounds for immediate removal and failure of course.
- D. The instructor will inform the student in writing that he/she may not return to clinical.
- D. An academic advisement form will be placed in the student's file located in the Student Affairs Office..
