

## **Policy Title: Eligibility for Graduation - Graduate Program**

To be eligible for graduation a student must:

1. Have a 3.0 or better cumulative grade point average.
2. Successfully complete the prescribed curriculum for which he/she is registered and meet all other requirements of the School of Nursing.
3. Supply the School of Nursing with official transcripts of courses taken outside the School.
4. Complete a minimum of 51 % credit hours at UTHSC-H School of Nursing or outreach campuses. These credit hours must include all clinical courses, preceptorship, and thesis or/ thesis options.
5. File an "Application for Degree" prior to the deadline established each term.
6. Prior to the deadlines established each term, successfully complete thesis/thesis option requirements and send the title of the project to Student Affairs.
7. Complete the graduate curriculum within five years from admission or have been granted an extension by the Masters Degree Council.
8. Pay required graduation fees.
9. Clear through all designated services on the clearance form.
10. Be enrolled during the term of graduation.
