## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

The Simulation Lab Faculty provides professional and technical expertise in the development, integration and utilization of simulation technology for faculty, students and staff. This faculty will serves as a clinical instructor for students during the clinical simulation teaching and assessment experience. The Clinical Simulation Lab Faculty reports to the Assistant Dean for e Learning and Educational Technology and functions administratively within the Board of Regents, Health Science Center and School of Nursing Policies and Procedures.

### **The Clinical Faculty Clinical Simulation and Performance Laboratory will:**

1. Work with course faculty to facilitate incorporation of simulation into UT at Houston School of Nursing courses.
2. Collaborates with faculty to develop and implement high quality learning and assessment simulations.
3. Collaborates with faculty to evaluate the effectiveness of simulation on the learning process.
4. Utilizes role-playing, props and dialogue to create a realistic learning environment.
5. Coordinates and implements clinical simulation experiences for undergraduate and graduate clinical courses
6. Provides training for faculty who desire more involvement in use of the simulators.
7. Assists with the programming of software scenarios utilized for simulation experiences based on course faculty identified specifications
8. Provides recommendations for budget and purchase of equipment, supplies and materials; assists in the identification of funding sources for use in simulation and clinical performance lab.
