

The University of Texas Health Science Center Houston School of Nursing is seeking applications for full-time and part-time faculty positions in the specialty area of **Adult Health, Community Health, Medical-Surgical, Maternal, Pediatrics, Psychiatric and Women's Health Nursing, Nurse Anesthesia, and Nursing Administration.**

Dynamic collaborative teaching teams composed of both masters prepared expert clinicians and advanced practice nurses and doctorally prepared faculty provide didactic, laboratory, simulation, and clinical learning experiences for students. Experience in teaching is preferred. A baccalaureate and a master's or doctoral degree in nursing and eligibility for licensure as a registered nurse in Texas are required. For advanced practice nurses, national certification in an advanced practice role and eligibility for approval to practice in the advanced practice nursing role in Texas are required. Teaching assignments and responsibility depend on the educational level and specialty practice area of the candidate. There are opportunities in both the undergraduate and graduate programs. The undergraduate program consists of a generic program, an accelerated one year program, and a RN-BSN track. The graduate programs include several nurse practitioner and clinical nurse specialist tracks.

Houston is a dynamic, cosmopolitan city less than an hour's drive from Gulf shores beaches. The School of Nursing recently moved into its new state of the art building which has received American Institute of Architects awards for its environmentally-sound features. The School, located in the Texas Medical Center, provides a rich interdisciplinary environment conducive to collaborative work in teaching, practice, and research. The University of Texas at Houston includes Schools of Nursing, Medicine, Dentistry, Public Health, Health Information Sciences, and the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences.
